1 長文読解 次の英文を読み、設問に答えなさい.

Some foreigners associate the idea of queuing (standing in an orderly line to wait for something) as a particularly British characteristic. However, in Britain, as in most other countries, people form queues for certain things, but not everything.

The British generally queue in shops, banks, post offices and anywhere they need to buy a ticket — such as a cinema, theatre or railway station. It is unusual to see British people queuing on a railway or underground platform when they are waiting for a train.

However, in 1938 — though only in London — a law was made to control how people queued. The law said that it was illegal for more than two people (1)stand next to each other in a bus queue, and also that it was illegal to 'queue jump' (to push or go straight to the front of the queue without (2)wait for their turn). The law stated that passengers must 'wait in lines or queues in an orderly manner.' If they did not, and if they were caught, they would have to pay a fine.

This law was finally (3)end on 1st January 1995. However, it is unlikely that many — or even any — Londoners were aware of it! Even though some British people (4)(it / queue / to / to / good / be / manners / consider), the only time people are likely to form a proper queue for a bus is if the pavement (where people walk) is very narrow.

Most British people are happy to queue patiently if they have to, but places where long queues are expected generally now have barriers or ropes. [263 語]
