- 4. That's so cool!: かっこいい! / すごい!(cool は冷たいという意味に加えてかっこいいという 意味でもよく使われます。)
- 5. It's ~ minutes away from ···.: それは···から~分離れたところにあります。
- 6. I would really love to go.: とっても行きたいです。
- 7. Let's make a plan to go together: 一緒に行く計画を立てましょう!
